**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Unauthorized Documents Regulations, 1988*.

**Commencement**

2. These regulations will come into operation on the day on which the *Unauthorized Documents Act Amendment Act, 1988*, comes into operation.

**Interpretation**

3. In these regulations—

"the Act" means the *Unauthorized Documents Act, 1916*.

**State Badge and official emblem**

3a. For the purposes of section 3a of the Act, the piping shrike is declared to be a State Badge and an official emblem of the State.

**State commercial emblems**

4. For the purposes of section 3b of the Act, the emblems depicted in the schedule are declared to be State commercial emblems.
