Legislative history

---

#### 1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Unclaimed Goods Regulations 1998*.

#### 2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

#### 3—Revocation

The *Unclaimed Goods Regulations 1987* (see *Gazette 30.7.1987 p295*) are revoked.

#### 4—Interpretation

In these regulations—

*the Act* means the *Unclaimed Goods Act 1987*.

#### 5—Variation of values in definitions of scale 1, scale 2 and scale 3

- (1) The value of \$100 referred to in the definitions of *scale 1* and *scale 2* in section 3(1) of the Act is varied to \$200.
- (2) The value of \$500 referred to in the definitions of *scale 2* and *scale 3* in section 3(1) of the Act is varied to \$1 000.

#### 6—Forms

- (1) A notice for the purposes of section 5(2)(d)(ii) of the Act must be in the form set out in Schedule 1.
- (2) A notice for the purposes of section 6(5)(b) of the Act must be in the form set out in Schedule 2.

## Schedule 1—Notice of request for collection of goods
