Legislative history

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Wine Grapes Industry Regulations 1993*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation four months after the day on which they are made (see *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978* section 10AA).

3—Production area

For the purposes of paragraph (g) of the definition of *production area* in section 3(1) of the *Wine Grapes Industry Act 1991*, the following hundreds are declared to be part of the production area:
