The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Statutes Amendment (Terrorism) Act 2015*.

2—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of Terrorism (Police Powers) Act 2005

3—Amendment of section 30—Review of Act

- (1) Section 30(1)—after paragraph (b) insert:
 - (c) the twelfth anniversary of the commencement of this Act; and
 - (d) the fourteenth anniversary of the commencement of this Act; and
 - (e) the sixteenth anniversary of the commencement of this Act; and
 - (f) the eighteenth anniversary of the commencement of this Act.

- (2) Section 30—after subsection (1) insert:
 - (1a) The Minister must, within the 4-month period preceding the expiry of this Act, cause the operation of this Act to be finally reviewed.

4—Amendment of section 31—Expiry of Act

Section 31—delete "tenth" and substitute: twentieth

Part 3—Amendment of Terrorism (Preventative Detention) Act 2005

5—Amendment of section 52—Sunset provision

Section 52—delete "10" wherever occurring and substitute in each case: 20

6—Transitional provision

Section 52 of the *Terrorism (Preventative Detention) Act 2005*, as amended by Part 3 of this Act, applies in relation to a preventative detention order or prohibited contact order whether the order was made before or after the commencement of Part 3.
