The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Statutes Amendment (Attorney-General's Portfolio)* (No 3) Act 2022.

2—Commencement

- (1) Subject to this section, this Act comes into operation on the day on which it is assented to by the Governor.
- (2) Part 2 comes into operation immediately after Schedule 1 of the *Voluntary Assisted Dying Act 2021* comes into operation.

Part 2—Amendment of Coroners Act 2003

3—Amendment of section 3—Interpretation

- (1) Section 3(1), definition of *reportable death*—after "subsection (2)" insert: or (2a)
- (2) Section 3(1), definition of *reportable death*, (ea)—delete paragraph (ea)

- (3) Section 3—after subsection (2) insert:
 - (2a) For the purposes of this Act, the death of a person is not reportable if the death occurs as a result of the administration of a voluntary assisted dying substance in accordance with the *Voluntary Assisted Dying Act 2021*.

4—Amendment of section 39—Annual report

Section 39(2)—delete "all recommendations made by the Coroner's Court under section 25 during that financial year" and substitute:

- (a) all recommendations made by the Coroner's Court under section 25 during that financial year; and
- (b) the number of notifications received by the State Coroner under section 84(2) of the *Voluntary Assisted Dying Act 2021* during that financial year.
