Election of Senators (Fixing of Dates) Proclamation 2004

under section 2 of the *Election of Senators Act 1903*

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Election of Senators (Fixing of Dates) Proclamation 2004*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Fixing of dates for 2004 election

For the purposes of the election of 6 Senators for the State of South Australia I fix the following dates:

- (a) 31 August 2004 as the date for the issue of the writ;
- (b) 7 September 2004 as the date for the close of the electoral rolls;
- (c) 16 September 2004 as the date for the nomination of candidates;
- (d) 9 October 2004 as the date for the polling;
- (e) 8 December 2004 as the date on or before which the unit must be returned.
