Crown Lands (Resumption of Dedicated Land) Proclamation 2007

under section 5AA(1)(c) of the *Crown Lands Act 1929*

Preamble

- 1 The following land is dedicated as a reserve for a cemetery (*Gazette 24.12.1896 p1419*):

Section 264, Hundred of Parnaroo, being the whole of the land contained in Land Grant Register Book Volume 619 Folio 67.
- 2 No registered proprietor of the land is able or willing to have the care, control and management of the land.

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Crown Lands (Resumption of Dedicated Land) Proclamation 2007*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Resumption of dedicated land

The land defined in the preamble to this proclamation is resumed.

4—Cancellation of grant of land

The grant of the land defined in the preamble to this proclamation is cancelled.
