# **Crown Lands (Resumption of Dedicated Land) Proclamation 2007**

under section 5AA(1)(c) of the Crown Lands Act 1929

# **Preamble**

The following land is dedicated as a reserve for Marine Board purposes (*Gazette* 21.1.1909 p112):

Section 178, Hundred of Dudley.

The following land is also dedicated as a reserve for Marine Board purposes (*Gazette* 11.7.1912 p42):

The land now identified as Section 417, Hundred of Dudley.

- The land described in clauses 1 and 2 is the whole of the land contained in Certificate of Title Register Book Volume 5795 Folio 342.
- The registered proprietor of the land defined in clauses 1 to 3 (inclusive) has requested the resumption of the land.

## 1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Crown Lands (Resumption of Dedicated Land) Proclamation 2007.* 

#### 2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

# 3—Resumption of dedicated land

The land defined in clauses 1 to 3 (inclusive) of the preamble to this proclamation is resumed.

## 4—Cancellation of grant of land

The grant of the land defined in clauses 1 to 3 (inclusive) of the preamble to this proclamation is cancelled.
