Crown Lands (Resumption of Dedicated Land) Proclamation 2007

under section 5AA(1)(c) of the *Crown Lands Act 1929*

Preamble

- 1 The following land is dedicated as a reserve for Marine Board purposes (*Gazette 21.1.1909 p112*):
Section 178, Hundred of Dudley.
- 2 The following land is also dedicated as a reserve for Marine Board purposes (*Gazette 11.7.1912 p42*):
The land now identified as Section 417, Hundred of Dudley.
- 3 The land described in clauses 1 and 2 is the whole of the land contained in Certificate of Title Register Book Volume 5795 Folio 342.
- 4 The registered proprietor of the land defined in clauses 1 to 3 (inclusive) has requested the resumption of the land.

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Crown Lands (Resumption of Dedicated Land) Proclamation 2007*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Resumption of dedicated land

The land defined in clauses 1 to 3 (inclusive) of the preamble to this proclamation is resumed.

4—Cancellation of grant of land

The grant of the land defined in clauses 1 to 3 (inclusive) of the preamble to this proclamation is cancelled.
