Mining (Revocation of Private Mine) Proclamation 2008

under section 73N of the *Mining Act 1971*

Preamble

- 1 The following area was declared to be a private mine by proclamation on 3 May 1973 (*Gazette 3.5.1973 p1926*):

All those portions of sections 5661, 2167 and 2166, hundred of Yatala, county of Adelaide, described in General Registry Office number 146, book 536, and closed road described in certificate of title, register book, volume 3768, folio 118.
- 2 The Warden's Court has declared (on 31 August 2006 in Action No 329 of 2006) that proper grounds exist for revoking the declaration referred to in clause 1.

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Mining (Revocation of Private Mine) Proclamation 2008*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Revocation of private mine

The declaration referred to in clause 1 of the preamble is revoked.
