Workers Rehabilitation and Compensation (Scheme Review) Amendment Act (Commencement) Proclamation 2009

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Workers Rehabilitation and Compensation (Scheme Review) Amendment Act (Commencement) Proclamation 2009*.

2—Commencement of suspended provisions

The following provisions of the *Workers Rehabilitation and Compensation (Scheme Review) Amendment Act 2008* (No 17 of 2008) will come into operation on 1 April 2009:

- (a) section 5(14);
- (b) section 41(7), insofar as it has not already been brought into operation;
- (c) section 70, but only insofar as it proposes the insertion of—
 - (i) Part 6C Division 2 (other than section 98E(e), (f), (n), (o) and (q) and section 98F(3)); and
 - (ii) section 98I,of the *Workers Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 1986*;
- (d) Schedule 1 clause 16.
