National Parks and Wildlife (Chadinga Conservation Park) Proclamation 2010

under section 30(1) of the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *National Parks and Wildlife (Chadinga Conservation Park) Proclamation 2010.*

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Constitution of Chadinga Conservation Park

The following Crown land is constituted as a conservation park and assigned the name *Chadinga Conservation Park*:

Sections 6, 10, 11, 20, 44 and 45, Hundred of Kevin;

Allotment 10 of Deposited Plan 34575, Hundred of Kevin;

Sections 18, 19, 20 and 25, Hundred of Giles;

Allotment 2 of Deposited Plan 34576, Hundred of Giles;

Section 31, Hundred of Cohen.
