Youth Court (Designation and Classification of Special Justices) Proclamation 2010

under section 9 of the *Youth Court Act 1993*

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Youth Court (Designation and Classification of Special Justices) Proclamation 2010*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Designation and classification of special justices

The special justices named in Schedule 1 are—

- (a) designated as special justices of the Youth Court of South Australia; and
- (b) classified as members of the Court's ancillary judiciary; and
- (c) declared to be members of the Court's ancillary judiciary—
 - (i) in the case of the special justice listed in Schedule 1 clause 1—until 24 January 2011;
 - (ii) in the case of the special justice listed in Schedule 1 clause 2—until 24 April 2014;
 - (iii) in the case of the special justice listed in Schedule 1 clause 3—until 29 October 2014;
 - (iv) in the case of the special justices listed in Schedule 1 clause 4—for a term of 5 years.
