# National Parks and Wildlife (Nullarbor Wilderness Protection Area—Hunting and Food Gathering by Aboriginal Persons) Proclamation 2013

under section 68D of the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972

## 1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *National Parks and Wildlife (Nullarbor Wilderness Protection Area—Hunting and Food Gathering by Aboriginal Persons) Proclamation 2013.* 

## 2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

### 3-Taking of plants, animals or eggs by Aboriginal persons permitted

- (1) Subject to subclause (2), an Aboriginal person may take a native plant or a protected animal or the eggs of a protected animal in pursuance of Part 5A Division 2 of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972* from the Nullarbor Wilderness Protection Area.
- (2) A plant, animal or egg must not be taken within 500 metres of the Eyre Highway.
