Crown Land Management (Revocation of Dedication) Proclamation 2014

under section 19(2) of the *Crown Land Management Act 2009*

Preamble

1 The following land is dedicated as a reserve for school purposes, not intended for ecclesiastical or denominational purposes (see *Gazette 19.7.1934 p73*) and has been granted in fee simple:

Section 174, Hundred of Paringa, Town of Lyrup, being the whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title Register Book Volume 5513 Folio 93.

2 It is now intended that the dedication of the land be revoked.

3 On revocation of the dedication the land reverts to the status of unalienated Crown land (see section 19(4) of the *Crown Land Management Act 2009*).

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Crown Land Management (Revocation of Dedication) Proclamation 2014*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Revocation of dedication of land

The dedication of the land defined in clause 1 of the preamble to this proclamation is revoked.
