Crown Land Management (Revocation of Dedication) Proclamation 2014

under section 19(2) of the Crown Land Management Act 2009

Preamble

The following land is dedicated as a reserve for electricity generation purposes (see *Gazette 5.4.1984 p840*) and has been granted in fee simple:

Allotment 3 in Deposited Plan 55666, Hundred of Davenport, County of Frome, being the whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title Register Book Volume 5843 Folio 706.

- 2 It is now intended that the dedication of the land be revoked.
- On revocation of the dedication the land reverts to the status of unalienated Crown land (see section 19(4) of the *Crown Land Management Act 2009*).

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Crown Land Management (Revocation of Dedication) Proclamation 2014.*

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Revocation of dedication of land

The dedication of the land defined in clause 1 of the preamble to this proclamation is revoked.
