Mining (Revocation of Private Mine) Proclamation 2017

under section 73N of the Mining Act 1971

Preamble

The following areas were declared to be a private mine by a proclamation made pursuant to the *Mining Act 1971* on 19 July 1973 (*Gazette 19.7.1973 p288*):

That portion of section 5536, hundred of Onkaparinga, county of Adelaide described in certificate of title register book, volume 3103, folio 160.

That portion of section 5539, hundreds of Onkaparinga and Yatala, county of Adelaide described in certificate of title register book, volume 3103, folio 161.

The Warden's Court has declared (on 14 June 2017 in Action No 581 of 2017) that proper grounds exist for revoking the declaration referred to in clause 1.

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Mining (Revocation of Private Mine) Proclamation 2017.*

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Revocation of private mine

The declaration referred to in clause 1 of the preamble is revoked.
