 - 5 The Warden's Court has declared (on 6 September 2017 in Action No 991 of 2017) that proper grounds exist for revoking the declarations referred to in clauses 1 to 4.

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Mining (Revocation of Private Mines) Proclamation 2017*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Revocation of private mines
