Natural Resources Management (Repeal of Suspended Provisions) Proclamation 2020

under clause 43(2) of Schedule 4 of the *Natural Resources Management Act 2004*

Preamble

- 1 Subclause (2) of clause 43 of Schedule 4 of the *Natural Resources Management Act 2004* provides that the Governor may, by proclamation, suspend the repeal of specified provisions of an Act that would otherwise be repealed by force of subclause (1) of that clause.
- 2 The repeal of Parts 1 and 8 of the *Water Resources Act 1997* was suspended by the *Natural Resources Management Act (Suspension of Repeal of Specified Provisions of Another Act) Proclamation 2005 (Gazette 30.6.2005 p2096)* until a day to be fixed by subsequent proclamation.
- 3 It is expedient that those provisions now be repealed.

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Natural Resources Management (Repeal of Suspended Provisions) Proclamation 2020*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Repeal of suspended provisions

Pursuant to clause 43(2) of Schedule 4 of the *Natural Resources Management Act 2004*, the day fixed for the repeal of Parts 1 and 8 of the *Water Resources Act 1997* is 9 April 2020.
