Schedule 1—Revocation of *Daylight Saving Regulations 2002*

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Daylight Saving Regulations 2003*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—South Australian summer time 2003-2004

The period for observance of South Australian summer time for 2003-2004 is the period from 2 am South Australian standard time on 26 October 2003 until 3 am South Australian summer time on 28 March 2004.

Schedule 1—Revocation of *Daylight Saving Regulations 2002*

The *Daylight Saving Regulations 2002* are revoked.
