Schedule—Plan of long term dry area

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Liquor Licensing (Dry Areas—Long Term) Variation Regulations 2003*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Schedule 1—after item headed "**Glenelg—Area 1**" insert:

Goolwa—Area 1

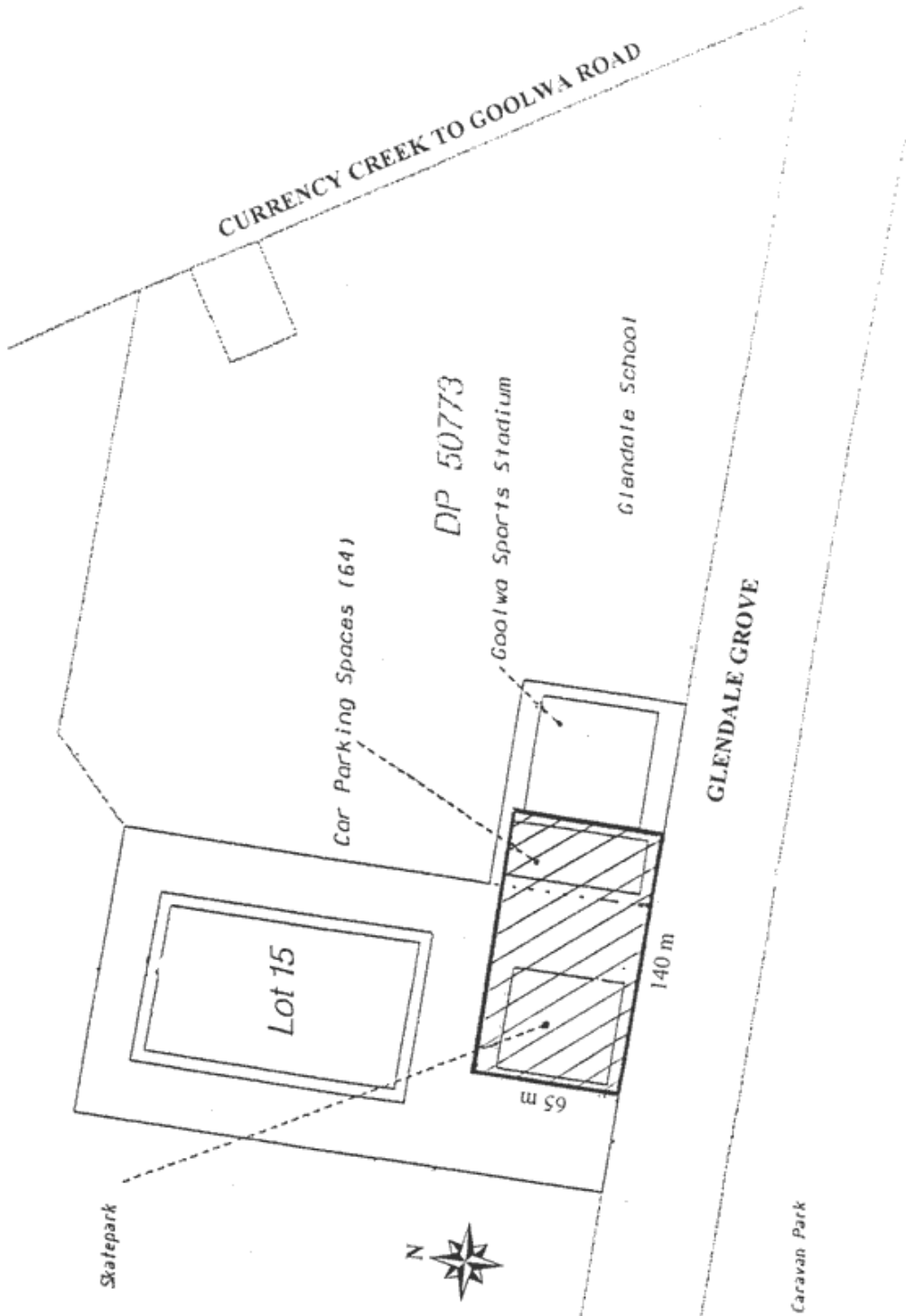
<i>Area</i>	<i>Period</i>	<i>Extent of prohibition</i>
The area adjacent to Goolwa, encompassing the Goolwa Skate Park and an abutting carpark, bounded as follows: commencing at the point at which the southerly prolongation in a straight line of the line of the western wall of the Goolwa Sports Stadium intersects the northern boundary of Glendale Grove, then westerly along that boundary of Glendale Grove for a distance of 140 metres, then northerly in a straight line at right angles to that boundary of Glendale Grove for a distance of 65 metres, then easterly in a straight line parallel to the northern boundary of Glendale Grove to the northerly prolongation in a straight line of the line of the western wall of the Goolwa Sports Stadium, then southerly along that prolongation, wall and the southerly prolongation in a straight line of the wall line to the point of commencement.	Continuous until 24 April 2004.	The consumption and possession of liquor are prohibited.
