# Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Lottery and Gaming Variation Regulations* 2003.

#### 2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on the day on which the *Lottery and Gaming (Lottery Inspectors) Amendment Act 2003* comes into operation.

## 3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

#### 4—Variation of regulation 4—Interpretation

Regulation 4(1), definition of *instant lottery*, (a)—delete "\$1 000" and substitute: \$5 000

### 5—Variation of regulation 29—Licence conditions

- (1) Regulation 29(1)(d)(i)—delete "in a manner that satisfies the Minister" and substitute: in such a manner
- (2) Regulation 29(1)(d)(ii) and (iii)—delete subparagraphs (ii) and (iii)
