Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Motor Vehicles Variation Regulations 2003*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 1 July 2003 immediately after the *Motor Vehicles Variation Regulations 2003* (No 59 of 2003) (*Gazette* 29.5.2003 p2161) come into operation.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.
