Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Occupational Therapists Variation Regulations 2003*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

Schedule 3—Fees

- 1 Application for registration—
 - (a) if the application is made in respect of the applicant's first year (or part year) of practice immediately following graduation and is made—

Part 2—Variation of *Occupational Therapists Regulations 1988* (Gazette 7 April 1988 p 895) as varied

- (i) between 1 July and 31 December (inclusive)..... \$100;
- (ii) between 1 January and 30 June (inclusive) \$50;
- (b) in any other case, if the application is made—
 - (i) between 1 July and 31 December (inclusive) in any year \$200;
 - (ii) between 1 January and 30 June (inclusive) in any year..... \$100.
- 2 Application for renewal of registration \$150.
