Recognised Hospital (Medicare Patients) Fees Variation Regulations 2003

under the South Australian Health Commission Act 1976

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Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Recognised Hospital (Medicare Patients) Fees Variation Regulations 2003*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 1 July 2003.

3—Variation provisions

(5) Schedule, clause 4(d)—delete "\$242.00" and substitute:

\$250.00

(6) Schedule, clause 7—delete "\$82.50" and substitute:

\$85.50
