### **Part 1—Preliminary**

#### **1—Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Miscellaneous) Variation Regulations 2003*.

#### **2—Commencement**

These regulations will come into operation on 1 March 2003.

##### **Note—**

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in this regulation.

#### **3—Variation provisions**

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

**5—Variation of regulation 15—Prescribed provisions for purposes of s. 79B**

Regulation 15(e)—delete "regulation 9A(1) and (2)" and substitute "regulations 9A(1), 9A(2) and 9B(1)".

**6—Variation of Schedule 9—Expiation Fees (Reg. 45)**

Schedule 9—table in Part 5, after item relating to regulation 9A(2) of the *Road Traffic (Road Rules—Ancillary and Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations 1999* insert:

9B(1) <i>Speeding while driving in built-up area</i>	
Exceeding 50 kph speed-limit—	
by less than 15 kph .....	131
by 15 kph or more but less than 30 kph.....	208
by 30 kph or more.....	312
