1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Essential Services Commission Regulations 2004*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Price determination relating to essential maritime industries

- (1) Subject to this regulation, the Commission may make a price determination relating to essential maritime industries, within the meaning of the *Maritime Services (Access) Act 2000*.
- (2) A price determination authorised by this regulation must specify an expiry date that is not later than the third anniversary of the date on which the determination takes effect.

Note—

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
