Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Fisheries (Fish Processors) Variation Regulations 2004*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 1 November 2004.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of *Fisheries (Fish Processors) Regulations 1991*

4—Variation of regulation 14—Delivery, storage and sale of rock lobster

- (1) Regulation 14(3)(e)—after "copies" insert:
 - of Parts B and C
- (2) Regulation 14(4)—after paragraph (b) insert:
 - (ba) within 48 hours of taking delivery of the rock lobster, deliver or cause to be delivered, the green copy of Parts B and C of the NZRL-CDR form completed in respect of the rock lobster to the holder of the licence pursuant to which the rock lobster were taken; and

(3) Regulation 14(8)—delete subregulation (8) and substitute:

- (8) If the provisions of this regulation require the completion of Parts A and C, or Parts B and C, of a NZRL-CDR form, the person who completes Part A or Part B (as the case requires) must not be the same person as the person who completes Part C of the NZRL-CDR form.

Maximum penalty: Division 7 fine.

Expiation fee: Division 9 fee.

Note—

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
