1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Liquor Licensing (Dry Areas—Long Term)* Variation Regulations 2004.

2—Commencement

(2) Schedule 1, item headed "Renmark—Area 1", column headed "Period"—delete "24 October 2004" and substitute:


