## **Local Government (General) Variation Regulations 2004**

under the *Local Government Act 1999*

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### **Part 1—Preliminary**

#### **1—Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Local Government (General) Variation Regulations 2004*.

#### **2—Commencement**

These regulations will come into operation on 1 July 2004.

#### **3—Variation provisions**

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

#### **4—Substitution of Schedule 2**

#### **Schedule 2—Prescribed fees**
