Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Motor Vehicles Variation Regulations 2004*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

4—Variation of Schedule 7—Demerit points

- (1) Schedule 7, Part 1, Division 1, item relating to section 79B(2) of the *Road Traffic Act 1961*—after the sub-item relating to rule 20 of the *Australian Road Rules* insert:
 - r. 56(1) *Failing to stop for red traffic light* 3
 - r. 56(2) *Failing to stop for red traffic arrow* 3
 - (2) Schedule 7, Part 1, Division 1, item relating to section 79B(2) of the *Road Traffic Act 1961*—after the sub-item relating to rule 60 of the *Australian Road Rules* insert:
 - r. 123(a) *Entering level crossing while warning lights are operating* 3
