Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Motor Vehicles Variation Regulations 2004*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

4—Variation of Schedule 7—Demerit points

- (1) Schedule 7, Part 1, Division 2, item relating to rule 57(2) of the *Australian Road Rules*—delete the item and substitute:

57(1)	<i>Failing to stop for yellow traffic light</i>	3
57(2)	<i>Failing to stop for yellow traffic arrow</i>	3

- (2) Schedule 7, Part 1, Division 2, item relating to rule 69(1) of the *Australian Road Rules*, description of offence—after "*at intersection*" insert:

(except roundabout)

- (3) Schedule 7, Part 2, Division 1, item relating to section 79B(2) of the *Road Traffic Act 1961*, description of offence, item relating to regulation 9B(1) of the *Road Traffic (Road Rules—Ancillary and Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations 1999*—delete the item relating to regulation 9B(1)
