Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Public Sector Management Variation Regulations 2004*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

4—Variation of regulation 5

- (1) Regulation 5(1)(a)—delete paragraph (a) and substitute:
 - (a) the pecuniary interests to be disclosed by a senior official for the purposes of section 6Q of the Act; and
- (2) Regulation 5(1)(b)—delete "Chief Executive or the Commissioner" and substitute:
senior official

5—Variation of regulation 18—Annual reports by public sector agencies (s 6B)

Regulation 18—delete "66" and substitute:

6B
