Road Traffic (Miscellaneous) Variation Regulations 2004

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Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Miscellaneous) Variation Regulations 2004.*

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3-Variation provisions
