1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Wine Grapes Industry Regulations 2004*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Interpretation

In these regulations—

Act means the *Wine Grapes Industry Act 1991*.

4—Production Area

For the purposes of paragraph (g) of the definition of *production area* in section 3(1) of the Act, those areas of the State south of latitude 32° South not already included (by that definition) in the production area are declared to be part of the production area.

Schedule 1—Revocation of *Wine Grapes Industry Regulations 1993*

1—Revocation

The *Wine Grapes Industry Regulations 1993* are revoked.

Note—

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
