### **Part 1—Preliminary**

#### **1—Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Chicken Meat Industry (Fees) Variation Regulations 2007*.

#### **2—Commencement**

These regulations will come into operation on 1 July 2007.

  - (b) processes between 1 million and 2 million meat chickens each year \$8 653

	(c) with less than 8 000 square metres in area of shed space available for growing meat chickens	\$324
