1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Chicken Meat Industry (Fees) Variation Regulations 2007.*

2—Commencement

	(a)	with more than 20 000 square metres in area of shed space available for growing meat chickens	\$973
	(b)	with shed space available for growing meat chickens of between 8 000 and 20 000 square metres in area	\$649
	(c)	with less than 8 000 square metres in area of shed space available for growing meat chickens	\$324
