## **Controlled Substances (Poisons) Variation Regulations 2007**

under the Controlled Substances Act 1984

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## Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Controlled Substances (Poisons) Variation Regulations 2007.* 

#### 2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

#### **3**—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

# 5—Variation of Schedule E—Schedule 2 poisons authorised to be sold by holder of a medicine sellers licence

Schedule E—delete "Pseudoephedrine (excluding packs of more than 30 dosage units)"
