Controlled Substances (Poisons) Variation Regulations 2007

under the *Controlled Substances Act 1984*

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Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Controlled Substances (Poisons) Variation Regulations 2007*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of *Controlled Substances (Poisons) Regulations 1996*

4—Variation of Schedule A—Modification of Uniform Poisons Standard

- (1) Schedule A(b)(viii)—delete subparagraph (viii)
 - (2) Schedule A(b)(x)—delete subparagraph (x)
 - (3) Schedule A(b)(xvi)—delete subparagraph (xvi)
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5—Variation of Schedule E—Schedule 2 poisons authorised to be sold by holder of a medicine sellers licence

Schedule E—delete "Pseudoephedrine (excluding packs of more than 30 dosage units)"
