## Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Environment Protection (Variation of Act, Schedule 1) Regulations 2007.* 

#### 2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation 28 days after the day on which they are made.

#### **3**—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of a specified Act varies the Act so specified.

## Part 2—Variation of Environment Protection Act 1993

# 4—Variation of Schedule 1 of the Act—Prescribed activities of environmental significance

Schedule 1, Part A, clause 6(1)(a) and (b)—delete paragraphs (a) and (b) and substitute:

- (a) in the case of poultry or poultry meat products—works with a rate of production exceeding 200 tonnes per year; or
- (b) in the case of any other animal meat or animal meat products works with a rate of production exceeding 100 tonnes per year.

Note—

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
