Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Harbors and Navigation (Fees) Variation Regulations 2007*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 1 July 2007.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Schedule 14—delete the Schedule and substitute:

Schedule 14—Fees

1—Waiver of fees and payment in instalments

- The CEO may waive or reduce the fee payable by a person under these regulations if the CEO considers the circumstances of the particular case justify the waiver or reduction.
- The CEO may allow a person to pay a fee in instalments.

2—Interpretation of table of fees

- In the table below, where a fee is expressed as an amount per metre, the fee is to be calculated for each metre or part of a metre in the length of the vessel.
- For the purposes of this Schedule, an observation vessel is to be regarded as a Class 3 vessel.
