1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Liquor Licensing (Dry Areas—Long Term) Variation Regulations* 2007.

2—Commencement

(2) Schedule 1, item headed "Maitland—Area 1", column headed "Period"—delete "31 March 2006" and substitute:


