Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Miscellaneous) Variation Regulations 2008*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on the day on which sections 27 and 30 of the *Statutes Amendment (Transport Portfolio) Act 2008* come into operation.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

4—Variation of Schedule 9—Expiation fees

(1) Schedule 9, Part 2—after the item relating to section 40Y(5) of the *Road Traffic Act 1961* insert:

45A Driving at speed exceeding applicable speed limit by 45 kph or more \$541

(2) Schedule 9, Part 2—after the item relating to section 91(3) of the *Road Traffic Act 1961* insert:

110C(2) Selling or offering for sale for use on roads motor vehicle or trailer not bearing vehicle identification plate for that vehicle or trailer—offence not committed in course of trade or business

110C(3) Driving motor vehicle or trailer not bearing vehicle identification plate for that vehicle or trailer
