Chicken Meat Industry (Fees) Variation Regulations 2009

under the Chicken Meat Industry Act 2003

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Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Chicken Meat Industry (Fees) Variation Regulations 2009*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 1 July 2009.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.
