Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Liquor Licensing (Dry Areas—Short Term) Variation Regulations 2009*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of *Liquor Licensing (Dry Areas—Short Term) Regulations 1997*

4—Variation of Schedule 1—Short term dry areas

Schedule 1—after the item headed "Spalding—Area 1" insert:

Streaky Bay—Area 1

(there is no plan for this area)

The area in and adjacent to the town of Streaky Bay bounded as follows: commencing at the point at which the prolongation in a	6 pm on 31 December 2009 to 8 am on 1 January 2010.	The consumption of liquor is prohibited and the possession of liquor is prohibited.

straight line of the western boundary of Linklater Street intersects the low water mark of Streaky Bay, then generally easterly along the low water mark to the point at which it is intersected by the prolongation in a straight line of the eastern boundary of Burke Street, then south-easterly along that prolongation and boundary of Burke Street to the northern boundary of the Flinders Highway, then easterly along that boundary of the Flinders Highway to the western boundary of Hospital Drive, then in a straight line by the shortest route (across the Flinders Highway) to the point at which the western boundary of East Terrace meets the southern boundary of the Flinders Highway, then south-easterly along the western boundary of East Terrace to the point at which it intersects the south-western boundary of Mudge Terrace, then north-westerly along the south-western boundary of Mudge Terrace to the point at which it meets the southern boundary of Wells Street, then generally south-westerly and westerly along the southern boundary of Wells Street to the point at which it intersects the western boundary of Linklater Street, then northerly along the western boundary of Linklater Street and the prolongation in a straight line of that boundary to the point of commencement. The area includes the whole of any jetty, boat ramp or other structure that projects below the low water mark from within the area described above (as well as any area beneath such a structure).

Note—

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
