1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Liquor Licensing (Dry Areas—Short Term) Variation Regulations* 2009.

Schedule 1—after the item headed "Tumby Bay—Area 1" insert:

Two Wells-Area 1

(there is no plan for this area)

The area in and adjacent to Two Wells comprising Old Port Wakefield Road between Mallala Two Wells Road and Canala Court.
