Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Public and Environmental Health (General) Variation Regulations 2009.*

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3-Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

4—Variation of regulation 4—Control of refuse

Regulation 4—after subregulation (3) insert:

(4) In order to facilitate compliance with subregulation (2), it is expected that a metropolitan council (within the meaning of the *Local Government Act 1999*) will provide a weekly kerbside waste collection service in respect of residential premises within its area. Note—
