1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Liquor Licensing (Dry Areas—Short Term) Variation Regulations 2010.*

4-Variation of Schedule 1-Short term dry areas

Schedule 1, item headed "Adelaide—Area 1 (Bonython Park)"—delete the item and substitute:

Adelaide—Area 1 (Ellis Park)
