1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Classification (Publications, Films and Computer Games) Regulations 2011.*

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on the day on which the *Classification* (*Publications, Films and Computer Games*) (*Exemptions and Approvals*) Amendment Act 2011 comes into operation.

3—Interpretation

In these regulations—

Act means the Classification (Publications, Films and Computer Games) Act 1995.

4—Applications in relation to exemptions

- (1) An application made under section 76, 77, 79 or 79A of the Act must comply with the requirements of the National Director.
- (2) The Minister may, in relation to an application made under section 76, 77, 79 or 79A of the Act that is being determined by the Minister, require the applicant to provide to the Minister any additional information of a kind that the Minister considers necessary to determine the application.

5—Application for revocation of decision of National Director

An application made to the Minister under section 79C for revocation of a decision of the National Director must be accompanied by—

- (a) a copy of the original application to which the decision of the National Director relates; and
- (b) a copy of the decision of the National Director; and
- (c) any additional information of a kind that the Minister considers necessary to determine the application.

Note—

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
