Liquor Licensing (Dry Areas—Short Term) Variation Regulations 2011

under the Liquor Licensing Act 1997

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Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Liquor Licensing (Dry Areas—Short Term) Variation Regulations 2011.*

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of Liquor Licensing (Dry Areas—Short Term) Regulations 1997

4-Variation of Schedule 1-Short term dry areas

Schedule 1—before the item headed "Semaphore—Area 1" insert:

Seacliff—Area 1

(there is no plan for this area)

The area in and adjacent to Seacliff	12.01 am on
bounded as follows: commencing at	26 January 2012 to
the point at which the western	12.01 am on
boundary of Marine Parade meets	28 January 2012.

The consumption of liquor is prohibited and the possession of liquor is prohibited.

the southern boundary of Young Street, then southerly along the western boundary of Marine Parade to the point at which it meets the southern boundary of Lot 7 of FP 148929, then westerly along the southern boundary of Lot 7, the southern boundaries of Lot 92 of FP 204007 and Lot 8 of FP 148929, and the prolongation in a straight line of the southern boundary of Lot 8, to the low water mark on the eastern side of Gulf St Vincent, then generally northerly along the low water mark to the point at which it is intersected by the prolongation in a straight line of the southern boundary of Young Street, then easterly along that prolongation to the eastern boundary of the Esplanade, then southerly along that boundary of the Esplanade to the northern boundary of Lot 1 of FP 148929, then easterly and southerly along the northern and eastern boundaries of Lot 1 to the northern boundary of Lot 2 of FP 148929, then easterly along that boundary of Lot 2 to the western boundary of Lot 4 of DP 3030, then northerly along that boundary of Lot 4 to the southern boundary of Young Street, then easterly along that boundary of Young Street to the point of commencement.

Note—

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
